- Become informed and prepared to proactively discuss current company issues or priority topics.
- Vote with careful consideration on matters such as current issues, policies, goals and objectives.
- Support resolutions and actions of the board of directors irrespective of personal opinion.
- Participate in the formulation, modernization, and approval of long-range strategies and objectives.
- Actively support special committees or projects.
- Promote Kid Stock to increase public support and awareness.
- Attend all special board activities/fundraising events (2-4 per year)
- Approve and monitor annual budgets.
- Monitor process for selecting, employing, and periodically evaluating the performance of the board officers, members, and executive director, offering best practice solutions as needed.
